May 17th - Letters go out to students for Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP), Academic Suspension and Dismissal. Students who are not reinstated by July 15th will be removed from their housing assignments.

July 30th - Pre-registered students who have not satisfied their bill for the fall semester will be removed from housing assignments and meals plans; a non-payment fee of \$150.00 will be assessed.

Need Housing?

Reserve the room you want. Apply for a housing assignment by May 1st. A deposit is required.



August 23rd - Removal for Non-Payment - Students who are not cleared financially will be removed from housing/meal plan and courses for non-payment of tuition and room and board fees. A hold will placed on the student's account and a reinstatement fee \$150.00 is required to register.
